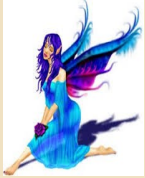

**SUPREME TEMPLE DAUGHTERS OF THE NILE
SUPREME TEMPLE ANNUAL SESSION 2016 – INDIANAPOLIS,
INDIANA LEGISLATION RESULTS TO THE SUPREME TEMPLE
BYLAWS**

Please be aware of the changes made to the Supreme Temple Daughters of the Nile Bylaws (2013 Revision) by the voting Delegates at the Supreme Temple One Hundredth Annual Supreme Session in Indianapolis, Indiana. These changes were effective as of the day enacted.

Amendment I-1 to PART I, ARTICLE IV SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION 1. Standing Committees (a), Page 40. *This amendment struck the word “six (6)” and inserted the word “ten (10)” in the first sentence and struck the word “three (3)” and inserted the word “two (2)” in the second sentence. As adopted, Section 1.(a) now reads:*

SECTION 1. Standing Committees

(a) *Action Team Committee shall be composed of one (1) Chairman and one (1) Vice-Chairman and at least ten (10) additional members of Daughters of the Nile. The Action Team Advisory Panel shall be composed of at least two (2) Past Supreme Queens. Supreme Princess Royal shall serve as an ex officio member.*

Amendment I-2 TO PART 1, ARTICLE VII SUPREME TEMPLE ANNUAL SESSION, SECTION 7 Legislation (a), (b) and (c). Page 51, as amended. *This amendment substituted a new Section 7 for the prior Section 7.*

As adopted, Section 7 now reads:

Section 7. Legislation

An Amendment with Previous Notice shall be submitted by email or regular mail in the proper format as detailed in the Manual of Procedures and Supreme Temple Daughters of the Nile website.

The proposed Amendment shall include the signatures of two (2) voting members, along with their names, title and Temple name and number.

*The signers shall submit the Amendment to the Chairman of the Jurisprudence Committee, **prior to the annual deadline of March 1**, in order for the Chairman and the Committee, and the Supreme Temple Parliamentarian to review it with the signers, and to ensure that the format, substance and wording of the Amendment is correct.*

*The Jurisprudence Committee shall send a copy of all Amendments as reviewed, to the Supreme Princess Recorder, **no later than April 15**.*

*The Supreme Princess Recorder shall send a copy of the Amendments to each member of the Supreme Temple Board of Directors and to the Subordinate Temples and post the Amendments on the Supreme Temple website, **no later than May 1**, prior to the Annual Session at which the legislation will be presented.*

Amendment I-3 to PART II, ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP, SECTION 1. Eligibility, Page 57. *This amendment, which would have inserted “or is a personal friend of a Daughter of the Nile” at the end of the first sentence, **was defeated**.*

Amendment I-4, PART II, ARTICLE IV OFFICIAL TEMPLE PROPERTIES, SECTION 2. Secret Work, Page 58. *Section 2, which would have reduced the number of times each year that the Junior Past Queen gives the Secret Work **was defeated**.*

Amendment I-5 to PART II, ARTICLE VI DUTIES OF OFFICERS, SECTION 1. Queen (k), Page 68.

This amendment inserted a new Section 1. (k).

As adopted, Section 1. (k) now reads:

(k) Complete the Inventory Form for Insurance purposes.

Note: Additional information on the updated insurance Inventory Form procedures has been inserted into the Manual of Procedures under Duties of the Queen.

Amendment I-6 to PART II, ARTICLE VII SUBORDINATE TEMPLE SESSIONS, SECTION 2.

Ceremonials, (a) and (b), Page 57, as amended. *This amendment, which would have increased obligatory Ceremonials from one (1) to two (2), was defeated.*

EDITING CHANGES TO THE SUPREME TEMPLE BYLAWS

*Please be aware of a housekeeping change for clarification and consistency purposes only made by vote of the Supreme Temple Board of Directors to PART II, ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP, SECTION 10, **Petition for Reinstatement**, Page 59. As clarified, SECTION 10, **Petition for Reinstatement** will now read:*

SECTION 10. *Petition for Reinstatement*

A woman who received a Demit or has been dropped for non-payment of dues and whose membership has not been restored within the one (1) year grace period may petition the Temple for reinstatement.

and

*SECTION 12. **Demit** will now read:*

SECTION 12. *Demit*

If a member in Good Standing wishes to dissolve her membership in Daughters of the Nile, she shall submit to the Temple Princess Recorder a written request for a Demit. The request shall be read at the next Stated Session and granted by the Queen.

Delete in its entirety the **CAUTION** statement:

CAUTION: *To take a Demit is the final step that will immediately dissolve all membership ties upon the reading and granting of the request during a Stated Session.*

CLARIFICATION CHANGES TO THE MANUAL OF PROCEDURES

Please be aware of two changes to the Manual of Procedures (2013 Revision) made by vote of the Board of Directors at the Annual Board Meeting held in Indianapolis, Indiana. These changes were effective as of the day enacted.

SECTION H. AFFILIATION WITH ANOTHER TEMPLE BY A MEMBER, 2., Page M-18, will now read:

2. A woman who has dissolved her membership with the granting of a Demit and wishes to return as a member in Daughters of the Nile, shall complete the Petition for Affiliation form with the names of two (2) sponsoring Members, include the Demit, Affiliation Fee, current prorated Annual Dies, and the Annual Per Capita.

and

SECTION N. DEMIT. Pages M-25 and M-26, will now read:

Members in Good Standing who wish to relinquish their membership may request a Demit in writing from the Princess Recorder. If a woman holds Dual Membership when she is granted a Demit, she automatically relinquishes her membership in the Dual Temple.

If a Demit request is received after the March Stated Session, but before **March 31**, the Princess Recorder shall inform the Queen. The Queen shall instruct the Princess Recorder to issue the Demit. The action shall be reported and recorded in the Minutes at the **April Stated Session**.

The Demit shall be granted by direction of the Queen following the reading of correspondence.

The membership and responsibilities of membership are dissolved.

A duplicate Demit may be requested by the woman and issued by the Princess Recorder.

A woman who has dissolved her membership with the granting of a Demit and wishes to return as a member in Daughters of the Nile, shall complete the **Petition for Affiliation** form.

A former Member may (i) submit a Petition for Affiliation in the same Temple and receive her original Membership Number or (ii) submit her Petition for Affiliation to become a member of another Temple.

In calculating Tenure of Membership, the woman who has been granted a Demit and returns to membership at a later date, loses the time as a member for the period between the granting of the Demit and the Affiliation.
