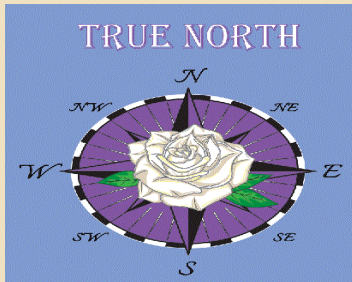

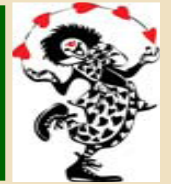
It is time for 2022 dues payments! Dues are \$41 this year and can be made with check, cash or card.
