Pageantry's Place

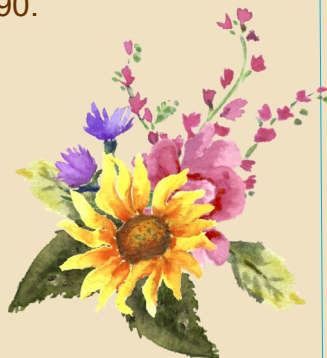

106th Supreme Session Legislation—pg 1

SUPREME TEMPLE DAUGHTERS OF THE NILE SUPREME TEMPLE ANNUAL SESSION 2022 – DALLAS, TEXAS LEGISLATION RESULTS TO THE SUPREME TEMPLE BYLAWS AND SUBORDINATE TEMPLE BYLAWS AND UPDATES TO THE RITUAL AND MANUAL OF PROCEDURES

Please be aware of the changes made to the Supreme Temple Daughters of the Nile Bylaws (2013.3 Revision) by the voting Delegates at the Supreme Temple One Hundred Sixth Annual Supreme Session in Dallas, Texas. These changes were effective as of the day enacted.

I. PARTS I AND II OF THE SUPREME TEMPLE AND SUBORDINATE TEMPLE BYLAWS

Amendment D-1 to PART I, ARTICLE I, SOVEREIGNTY AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE, SECTION 4, Supreme Temple Membership which would have expanded voting rights at Supreme Session to all members holding a current dues card and who are registered for the current Supreme Session **was defeated**.

Amendment D-2 to PART I, ARTICLE I, SOVEREIGNTY AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE, SECTION 7, Ritualistic Properties and Philanthropy, (e) Philanthropy [page S-4]. **As adopted**, SECTION 7. (e) now reads:

(e) Philanthropy

1. *The sole philanthropy of the Order is the support of the Shriners Hospitals for Children® through donations to the Daughters of the Nile Foundation and the Canadian Foundation. For other International Temples and Clubs, philanthropic support is given to the needs of Shriners' patients in the country of the International Temple or Club.*
2. *All fundraising activities undertaken by Subordinate Temples, Units, and Clubs shall conform to the values and Tenets of Daughters of the Nile. Subordinate Temples, Units, and Clubs shall adhere to the Fundraising Guidelines included in the Manual of Procedures.*
3. *This Bylaw does not preclude a Subordinate Temple from raising and donating funds on behalf of the Subordinate Temple for purposes of marketing and promoting Daughters of the Nile.*

Amendment D-3 to PART II, ARTICLE I, FORMATION/DISSOLUTION, SECTION 5, Dissolution, (e) Dissolution Procedures [page SB-4]. **As adopted**, SECTION 5. (e) now reads:

(e) Dissolution Procedures

Except for an amount not to exceed two thousand dollars (\$2,000), which may be retained for the benefit of establishing a Club in the city, or another convenient city of the Club's choice, of the dissolved Temple, the net proceeds, after all bills are paid, shall be sent to the United States Supreme Temple General Fund or to the Canadian Supreme Temple General Fund.

Amendment D-4 to PART I, ARTICLE III, SUPREME ELECTIVE OFFICERS, SECTION 7, (a) Supreme Princess Badoura, 7. Candidate Responsibility, b. [page S-26]. **As adopted**, Section 7. (b) is stricken. The location site and exact dates for the Supreme Session when Supreme Princess Badoura will be installed as Supreme Queen, will no longer be announced during her campaign speech.

Amendment D-5 to PART I, ARTICLE IV SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION 1, Standing Committees, (d) Code of Conduct Committee [page S-30], which would have changed the composition of the Code of Conduct Committee **was withdrawn** by the maker of the motion.

Amendment D-6 to PART I, ARTICLE IV, SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION 1, Standing Committees, (f) Coordinator of Hospital Requests Committee [page S-31]. **As adopted**, the title of the Committee was changed and Section 1. (f) now reads:

(f) Hospital Requests Committee shall be composed of one (1) Past Supreme Queen, to serve as Chairman, and up to twenty (20) Ambassadors to assist the Chairman to send and receive all information and requests from Shriners Hospitals for Children® personnel to the Chairman of Hospital Requests. The Ambassadors shall serve as liaisons between the Shriners Hospitals for Children® and the Chairman of Hospital Requests, as well as with the Subordinate Temple Chairman/Sewing Committee at the request of the Chairman of Hospital Requests.

** Definition: The name, Shriners Hospitals for Children® includes all Shriners' hospitals, medical centers, free-standing clinics, and any references to Shriners Children's™.*

Amendment D-7 to PART I, ARTICLE IV, SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION 1, Standing Committees, (g) Finance Committee [page S-31]. **As adopted**, SECTION 1. (g) now reads:

(g) Finance Committee shall be composed of two (2) Past Supreme Queens, one (1) to serve as Chairman. The Committee shall:

1. *Submit at the Annual Meeting of the Board of Directors and at the Annual Session of the Supreme Temple, a line-item budget showing the anticipated receipts and expenditures for the ensuing year and a detailed report itemizing expenditures for the previous two (2) years ending April 30, prior to the Annual Session.*

- a. Present the budget in writing, with a copy for all Delegates attending the Annual Session.
- b. Include in the Annual Report of the committee, such information as the Chairman deems appropriate.
2. Review all bids and contracts for all items supplied by the Supreme Princess Recorder.
3. Approve Limited Events Dispensations.
4. Receive the Certified Public Accountant's Report from the Supreme Princess Recorder.

Amendment D-8 to PART I, ARTICLE IV, SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION 1. Standing Committees (a) Financial Review of Subordinate Temples Committee [page S-32]. **As adopted**, SECTION 1. (i) now reads:

- (i) *Financial Review of Subordinate Temples Committee shall be composed of one (1) Past Supreme Queen to serve as Chairman, and three (3) appointed Past Queens.*

The Chairman shall:

Review and update the Supreme Biannual Financial Review and Certification form for distribution by the Supreme Princess Recorder to all Temple Princesses Recorder.

The Chairman shall officially notify:

- (1) *Each Past Queen of her assigned list of Temples to financially review and include a letter of instructions; and*
- (2) *The Temples of their assigned Past Queen.*

The Past Queens shall be responsible for working with the Subordinate Temples to receive the proper information and to complete the assigned review within the designated deadline.

Amendment D-9 to PART I, ARTICLE VII, SUPREME TEMPLE ANNUAL SESSION, SECTION 3. Registration (a) [page S-40]. **As adopted**, SECTION 3 (a) now reads:

- (a) A Registration fee shall be paid to the Hostess Temple.
1. U.S. members shall remit eighty dollars (\$80) in U.S. funds.
 2. Canadian members shall remit eighty dollars (\$80) in Canadian funds.
 3. Members from Other International Temples and Clubs shall remit an amount determined by a mathematical formula derived from calculating the current value of the foreign currency compared to the U.S. dollar and adjusting it dependent upon the median income of the International country to determine the fair Registration fee. Such calculation shall be completed prior to the publication of the Supreme Temple Packet each year.

Amendment D-10 to PART II, MEMBERSHIP, SECTION 1. (a) Eligibility [page SB-6] which would have allowed a woman of good character who is eighteen (18) years of age or older and vouched for by well-acquainted Members to be eligible for membership **was defeated**.

Amendment D-11 to PART II, ARTICLE II, MEMBERSHIP, SECTION 13. Obligation Only Initiation [page SB-9] which deleted the requirement for the Supreme Queen to approve of administering the Obligation Only Initiation at a Temple Session **was adopted**. **As adopted**, SECTION 13. now reads:

SECTION 13. Obligation Only Initiation

In extenuating circumstances, and with the vote of the Temple, a Temple may initiate a petitioner(s) with the Queen or Past Queen designate administering the Obligation at a Temple Session, a Temple Club, or other appropriate place. The Member(s) so initiated shall sign the Membership Book and receive her/their Membership Pin(s). The Christening Ceremony may be performed at an Obligation Only initiation.

Amendment D-12 to PART II, ARTICLE III, FINANCE, SECTION 1. Annual Per Capita, (d) [page SB-10] which would have required the Canadian General Fund to submit its percentage of the total Supreme Temple Administrative Expenses in United States currency **was defeated**.

Amendment D-13 to PART II, ARTICLE VI, DUTIES OF OFFICERS, SECTION 6. Princess Recorder (f) Financial Responsibilities 3. [page SB-28]. **As adopted**, SECTION 6, (f) 3. now reads:

3. *Provide all financial documents necessary for the Financial Review Committee to prepare the Annual Subordinate Temple Financial Review.*

Amendment D-14 to PART II, ARTICLE VII, SUBORDINATE TEMPLE SESSIONS, SECTION 2. Ceremonials, (a) [page SB-32]. **As adopted**, now reads:

SECTION 2. Ceremonials

- (a) *Each Temple shall hold at least two (2) Ceremonials annually, one (1) to be at the time of the Official Visit of the Supreme Queen and one (1) may be an Obligation Only Initiation, which may or may not be included in a Stated Session. Upon request of the Queen, and at the sole discretion of the Supreme Queen, either an Obligation Only*

Initiation or an informal "town hall" may be held instead of a formal Ceremonial at the Official Visit of the Supreme Queen.

Amendment D-15 to PART II, ARTICLE IX CLUBS, SECTION 1. United States and Canada (c) [page SB-36]. As adopted, now reads:

SECTION 1. United States and Canada

(c) *A Club shall not be named for any individual.*

Amendment D-16 to PART I, ARTICLE IV, SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION 1. Standing Committees, (a) Action Team Committee [page S-28] was withdrawn by the maker of the motion.

II. UPDATE TO THE RITUAL

Please be aware of a change to the Ritual (2018 revision) [Page 13], made by vote of the Board of Directors at the Annual Board Meeting held in Dallas, Texas. This change was effective as of the day enacted.

➤ **Needed to Open Temple:**

***Add Country Flags** [In North America, there is no requirement for a Temple to purchase a Brazilian flag, but if you have one it should be displayed together with the American and Canadian flags in the order shown in the Floor Chart that will be revised this year.]*

***Add Temple Banner** [If your Temple Banner is very old and in delicate condition, you may make a new Banner for general use and display in the Temple. The historical Banner may be displayed on special occasions.]*

Please note that the Supreme Princess Recorder will distribute a sticky page to the Subordinate Temples in order to update the Ritual.

III. UPDATES TO MANUAL OF PROCEDURES

Please be aware of changes to the Manual of Procedures (2013.3 revision) made by vote of the Board of Directors at the Annual Board Meeting held in Dallas, Texas. These changes were effective as of the day enacted.

B. VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF CHARTER

2. PERMANENT LETTER OF GOOD STANDING

The name of the Permanent Letter of Good Standing is changed to **TRANSFERABLE LETTER OF GOOD STANDING**. This section shall now read as follows:

*Members in Good Standing at the time a Temple relinquishes its Charter shall receive a **Transferable Letter of Good Standing** from the Supreme Princess Recorder if they do not participate in a Group Transfer of Membership to another Temple.*

Such Members shall be entitled to visit any Temple with the Transferable Letter of Good Standing and may petition any Temple for Affiliation, both actions within a one (1)-year period from the date the Transferable Letter of Good Standing was issued. If a Member holding a Transferable Letter of Good Standing does not affiliate with another Temple within that year, she will be dropped from membership and will no longer be entitled to visit any Temple.

5. GROUP TRANSFER OF MEMBERSHIP FOR TEMPLES VOLUNTARILY SURRENDERING THEIR CHARTERS

a. *When a Temple voluntarily surrenders its Charter, all Members in Good Standing shall become a group transfer to a Subordinate Temple of their choice ("Receiving Temple") as Affiliated Members. Sufficient money to cover both the Annual Dues and the Per Capita for the transferred Members must be sent by the Closing Temple to the Receiving Temple.*

➤ **SECTION II. MEMBERSHIP** [page M-25]

N. DEMIT

Delete the second sentence of the opening paragraph. A member will no longer lose her entire membership if she demits from only one of her plural Temples. The opening paragraph will now read as follows:

A Member in Good Standing who wishes to relinquish her membership in any one or all of her Temples, may request a Demit in writing from the Princess Recorder. If demits are desired from all Temples, each Temple must be addressed individually.

- **SECTION II. MEMBERSHIP** [page M-29]

R. MISCELLANEOUS

3. United States or Canadian Temples may charge petitioning women who live in foreign countries initiation fees in amounts equivalent to that foreign country's currency.

- **SECTION XVII. RECORDS RETENTION AND DISPOSAL, 20.** [page M-149]

Delete number 20 in its entirety. It is no longer required for a Temple to retain any copies of Supreme Temple Proceedings. If a Temple wishes, it may distribute archived Proceedings to any interested member or simply destroy them.

- **SECTION XVI. REQUIRED PRACTICES OF THE ORDER** [page M-139]

IV. GENERAL PROCEDURAL CHANGES LISTED HERE FOR YOUR INFORMATION

1. Brazil is granted the right to make Daughters of the Nile official membership pins in their country. The quality of the Nile jewelry they currently make is excellent.
2. Temples with Members in International Clubs may use videoconferencing (such as webinars, but NOT a Zoom format) to allow the foreign Members to watch Sessions and full Ceremonials, including all ritualistic work.
3. If a Temple wishes to use fund transferring payment methods such as Zelle, Venmo, and/or PayPal, such account may ONLY be opened under the tax ID of the Temple itself and NEVER may any Member open a personal account for the Temple's use. NO EXCEPTIONS!
4. The Supreme Queen will now be checking the financial records of the Temple Princess Banker when she makes her official visit to the Temple. Please refer to the letter sent to each Temple by the Supreme Princess Banker dated June 2, 2022.
5. Supreme Queen Vickie Tabor Hill is being allowed, for only a one (1)-year period, to create a shortened Ritual, allow a smaller quorum [less than eleven (11)], and put in place "performance contracts" for struggling Temples. Temples interested in a reprieve from the normal requirements may appeal to Supreme Queen Vickie.
6. Despite the "branding change" by Shriners International to use the name Shriners Children's™ instead of Shriner Hospitals for Children®, we will NOT switch to the use of that branding name in the contents of the Green Book. Branding names can change frequently and the legal name of Shriner's Hospitals for Children® will not be changing. Either name may be used by Supreme Temple Committees and the Subordinate Temples in their publications.
7. The Code of Conduct is being revised so that it emphasizes the role of a Subordinate Temple in handling the review and trial process within the Temple itself. The role of the Supreme Temple Code of Conduct Committee is purely to help a Temple interpret the rules contained in the booklet, not to conduct the process unless the Temple is unable to resolve its own issues. It is best if a Subordinate Temple can settle its own problems.
