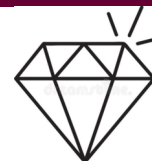
Thank you to everyone who wore a costume at installation and helped to make our entrance beautiful!

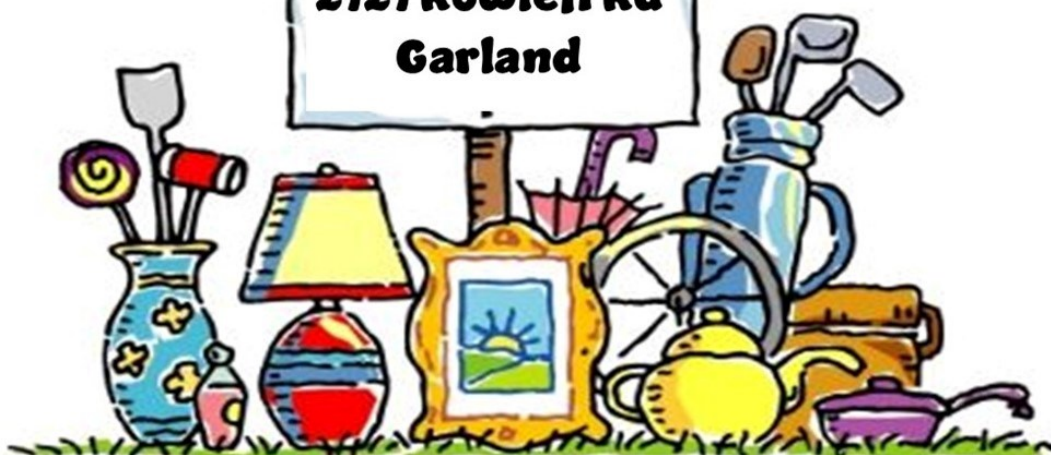
